ACTION: Notice of Availability of an Environmental Assessment

SUMMARY: Notice is hereby given that RD, as required by the National Environmental Policy Act, is issuing an environmental assessment (EA) in connection with possible impacts related to a project proposed by the City of Chetek, Barron County, WI. The proposal is for construction of a new wastewater treatment facility and supporting infrastructure. The City of Chetek has submitted an application to RD for funding of the proposal.

SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION: City of Chetek proposes to construct a new wastewater treatment facility and improve existing wastewater infrastructure.

CBS2, an environmental consultant, prepared an environmental assessment for RD that describes the project, assesses the proposed project's environmental impacts, and summarizes as applicable any mitigation measures used to minimize environmental effects.

RD has conducted an independent evaluation of the environmental assessment and believes that it accurately assesses the impacts of the proposed project. No significant impacts are expected as a result of the construction of the project.

Questions and comments should be sent to RD at the address provided. RD will accept questions and comments on the environmental assessment for 14 days from the date of publication of this notice.

Any final action by RD related to the proposed project will be subject to, and contingent upon, compliance with all relevant Federal environmental laws and regulations and completion of environmental review procedures as prescribed by 7 CFR Part 1970, Environmental Policies and Procedures.
